Plugins

I have created custom plugins for companies that used WordPress a CMS.

Proprietary WordPress Plugins

Plugin I've created for private companies have been as simple as a small Admin UI change, and as large as a Bidder verses Bidder auction website.

An other example of a plugin was an event management tool for a Software Company that needed to organize user training seminars and newsgroup meet ups.

The plugin allows a visitor to sign up a team of attendees to a specific event. Once the sign up process has been completed the attendees are notified by email with the event information.

Events and Attendees are managed within the WordPress wp-admin area by the site owner.

Open Source WordPress Plugins

I currently have four public plugins located in the WordPress Plugin Directory² **Easy Sign Up** is by far my most successful WordPress plugin to date. It has been downloaded over 72,000 times and has a five star rating on WordPress.org.

Easy Sign Up is a very simple plugin that collects email addresses and then redirects the visitor to a URL. The plug-in generates a customizable thank you email that's sent to the visitor and the visitor's email and name are sent to an email address of your choosing. Possible use is collecting email address for a newsletter, or leads for your sales force before redirecting to a brochure.
